ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, PROHIBITING THE USE OF COMPRESSION BRAKES WITHIN THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Fernan Lake village, Kootenai County, Idaho:

SECTION I: The City Council finds that the use of compression brakes, also known as "jake brakes," within the limits of the City of Fernan Lake Village creates an unacceptable noise level against the peace and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fernan Lake Village.

SECTION II: No person shall, within the incorporated limits of the City of Fernan Lake Village, use or operate compression brakes.

SECTION III: As used herein, "compression brakes," also known as "jake brakes," shall mean a devise or mechanism used on some motor vehicles, usually trucks, for the purpose of slowing or braking the motor vehicle. Such devise utilizes engine compression and when activated a noise is emitted which is substantially in excess of the normal noise of the vehicle.

SECTION IV: A violation of this Ordinance shall constitute an infraction and is punishable by a penalty not exceeding ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00). Uniform citations may be issued to a violator, and other proceedings shall be had including the imposition of fixed penalties, all as provided.

Infraction Rules for the state of Idaho in effect at the time the citation is issued.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, the official newspaper of the City of Fernan Lake Village.
