AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE CITY LIMITS ONE QUARTER (1/4) MILE OVER THE SURFACE WATERS OF FERNAN LAKE; AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A NAVIGABLE WATER DISTRICT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fernan Lake Village is integrally related to Fernan Lake, and

WHEREAS, the property values and health, safety and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Fernan require protection of fish and wildlife habitat, aquatic life, recreation, aesthetic beauty and water quality in and upon Fernan Lake, and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 50-221 authorizes cities situated upon navigable lakes to extend their boundaries or limits over navigable lakes, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

Section 1.00: The boundaries and city limits of the City of Fernan Lake Village shall be, and the same are hereby, fixed, determined and extended over the surface waters of Fernan Lake for a distance of one-fourth (1/4) mile (1,320 feet) from the low-water mark of Fernan Lake in all directions extending from the existing city limits of the City of Fernan Lake Village as the same intersect with said natural ordinary low-water mark.

Section 2.00: The City of Fernan Lake Village shall hereafter adopt a Navigable Water District for the purpose of regulating use

of the waters of Fernan Lake within the extended boundaries for the protection of health, safety and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Fernan Lake Village.

Section 3.00: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in at least one (1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in Kootenai County, Idaho, hereby declared to be the official newspaper for the publication of this ordinance.

PASSED and ADOPTED as an Ordinance of the City of Fernan Lake Village, Kootenai County, Idaho, in a special session of the City Council on the _20_ day of November, 1995.
