ordinance no. 124

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, KOOTENAI COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO, PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO CAUSE ANY DIRT, SOIL, DEBRIS, LITTER, WASTE, WASTE WATER, HAZARDOUS WASTE, COMMERCIAL BY-PRODUCTS, OR OTHER FOREIGN MATERIALS BY ANY MEANS TO BE DEPOSITED UPON ANY PUBLIC STREET, SIDEWALK, THOROUGHFARE, STORM DRAIN, OR OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING THAT A VIOLATION SHALL CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Fernan Lake Village, Kootenai County, Idaho:

SECTION 1: It is unlawful for any person to deposit or cause to be deposited, thrown upon or moved onto, dumped, released or poured onto any public street, sidewalk, thoroughfare, storm drain, or any other public property, any dirt, soil, rocks, debris, waste, waste water, hazardous waste, sewage, petroleum products, or commercial by-products.

SECTION 2: As used herein, the term "hazardous waste" shall have the same meaning as provided in Idaho Code § 39-4403(8) and the word "waste" shall have the meaning set forth in Idaho Code § 39-4403(22), as such statute is currently in effect, or as may be hereafter amended.

SECTION 3: Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment, for each offense.

SECTION 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, the official newspaper of the City of Fernan Lake Village, Idaho.
