## ORDINANCE NO. 147

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, PROHIBITING THE SALE OF BEER AND WINE BETWEEN 2:00 A.M. AND 6:00 A.M.; PROHIBITING THE SALE OF LIQUOR BETWEEN 2:00 A.M. AND 10:00 A.M. AND ALLOWING THE SALE OF LIQUOR ON SUNDAY, MEMORIAL DAY AND THANKSGIVING; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

## Section 1. Alcoholic Beverage Hours of Sale Restricted.

It is unlawful for any person to sell beer and wine between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. and liquor to be consumed on the premises between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and ten o'clock (10:00) A.M. In addition to the days on which liquor may be sold pursuant to Title 23, Chapter 9 of the Idaho Code, liquor may be sold on Sunday, Memorial Day and Thanksgiving.

Section 2. The ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be read to carry out the purpose(s) of the ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

**Section 3.** That all current ordinances and parts of ordinances of the City of Fernan Lake Village which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
