ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OWNER OR KEEPER OF DOGS IN THE CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE FROM KEEPING SAID DOGS EXCEPT ON THE PREMISES OF THE OWNER OR KEEPER UNLESS SAID DOG BE CONTROLLED BY LEASH OR CONFINED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE; PROHIBITING THE ABUSING OR MOLESTING OF DOGS; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF DOGS FOUND RUNNING AT LARGE IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND THE MANNER OF REDEEMING THE SAME; PROVIDING FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF DOGS IF NOT REDEEMED; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Fernan Lake Village, Kootenai County, Idaho:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to allow or permit his dog to remain upon any street or alley within the City of Fernan Lake Village or upon any place thereon or upon any premises other than the premises of the owner of such dog or the one having charge thereof, unless (a) such dog be in charge of a person and controlled by a leash not exceeding ten (10) feet in length; or (b) such dog be confined in a motor vehicle.

SECTION II: It shall be unlawful for any person within the City to maliciously kill, maim or wound a dog or to cruelly beat, mutilate, torture, or torment any dog,
