ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE, DEFINING FIREARMS, and PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of Fernan Lake Village, Idaho:

SECTION I: DEFINITION: The term Firearm as used in this chapter, shall mean any instrument used in the propulsion of shot, pellets, or bullets, or other harmful objects by the action of gunpowder exploded within the instrument or by the action of compressed air within it.

SECTION II: DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge firearms of any kind or description within the limits of Fernan Lake Village; provided, however, that this shall not apply to police officers in the discharge of their duties.

SECTION III: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by fine not exceeding \$100, or imprisonment not exceeding thirty days, or both.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication in one issue of the Kootenai County Leader, a newspaper of general circulation in Kootenai County, Idaho.

Passed under suspension of rules upon which a rollcall was taken and duly enacted an Ordinance of Fernan Lake Village at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held on the 12th day of December, 1958.
