

RESOLUTION NUMBER 171

CITY OF FERNAN LAKE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the sewer system for the City of Fernan Lake Village, which consists of forty-one (41) lift-stations, pumps, and electric controls, is thirty-six (36) years old; and in the last two (2) years there has been a dramatic increase in pump and control failures at various sewer lift-stations; and those failures have severely inconvenienced and aggravated the affected residents and have significantly increased the City's cost to maintain its sewer system.

WHEREAS, the mayor and city council have studied a plan prepared by the city engineer for a systematic replacement of the sewer system's pumps and controls that could take up to ten (10) years.

WHEREAS, the cost of the planned replacement of pumps and controls will exhaust or significantly deplete the City's reserve account unless additional revenues are received.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on July 9, 2012, on a proposed increase of monthly sewer fees charged to the residential lot owners within the City pursuant to Idaho Code section 63-1311A with notice of that hearing having been mailed to the City's residents in accordance with that statute.

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of the City of Fernan Lake Village that the fee charged by the City for sewer service to each residential lot is increased by FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) per month beginning August 2012.
